




Sutton Park Community Primary School- Year 3

PE will be on a Monday afternoon & Swimming on Friday afternoon. Please make sure your child has their named PE kit in school.



Rationale: In order to improve the quality of our writing, we will be exploring and creating a range of fiction and non-fiction texts to ensure we can apply our learning from other subjects in different ways.

English

In English we will be reading 'Nibbles the Book Monster' by Emma Yarlett and 'Little Evie in the Wild Wood' by Jackie Morris. We will be looking more closely at the structure of traditional stories and how we can adapt these and use them to develop our own story writing. In guided reading we will be looking at the 'Little Evie' text itself and we will also be looking at other variations of traditional tale texts and non-fiction texts such as 'Creaturepedia' by Adrian Barman.

PE

On Fridays the children will be going swimming. They will be developing water confidence and learning how to stay safe in the water.

Indoor PE We will be practising our gymnastic skills. We will also be learning how to use the equipment safely.

Science

In Science we will be looking at how animals need the right type of food and that they get nutrition from what they eat. We will also look at how muscles and skeletons provide support, protection and movement.

Autumn 1 2018 Into the Woods

Art We will use the forest school area to create Andy Goldsworthy style pictures. We will create backgrounds using a wash and use sketching pencils to shade and show tone and texture.

Music In Music the children will be exploring how sounds can be organised and using instruments to create repeating patterns.

French We will be learning basic greetings as well as colours and numbers to 10.

Geography

We will be looking at woodlands and forests and their climates. We will be learning about the physical and human features of the world around us.

Computing We will be learning about e safety and how to make a branching database.

RE We will be studying Christianity. The children will find out what it means to be a Christian in Britain today.

PSHE We will be focussing on our emotions and how to deal with them appropriately.

Thrive We will be finding ways to manage conflict as well as learning what is socially acceptable in different situations.

Mathematics

In Maths pupils will count in 4s, 8s, 50s and 100s. They will learn how to read and write all the numbers to 1000. We will also be finding 10 more and 10 less. The children will learn their 3, 4 and 8 x tables. We will teach how to add and subtract 3 digit numbers and how to multiply 2 digit numbers. Mental maths lessons will be taught each week working on basic number skills and times tables.

Home Learning

Home Learning will be an ongoing project, which they will be working on weekly building up to a final presentation on Thursday 25th October.
