



Toys



PE will be on Monday and Tuesday. Make sure all items of clothes are clearly named. We have outdoor learning on Wednesday afternoons. Please join us at 2.45pm on Thursdays for Family Reading.

Maths

In Maths we will continue to learn number bonds that total 10 and 20 and we will practise using them so we can add and subtract quickly. We will name and describe 2D shapes. We will practise counting in 2s, 5s 10s forwards and backwards and learn to write numbers to 100 in words. We will also find half and quarter of a shape and a number and compare and describe capacity and volume using words like full, empty and half full.

History

During the first week back we will be learning about Guy Fawkes and the significance of Bonfire night. Then we will learn about toys starting with modern toys and comparing them with toys from past.

Design Technology

As a class we will look at a selection of toys that roll. We will use this to design our own simple rolling toy using a range of joining techniques.

PE.

In outdoor games we will continue to practise throwing, catching and rolling skills by aiming at simple targets. We will be exploring how different toys move and use these ideas to move to music. As well as this we will have a go at skipping to traditional rhymes and chants.

Computing

We will use a program to create a firework picture then print it out. We will learn about Internet safety and how we must keep our password safe and personal information private.

Science

In Science the class will be naming materials and identifying and sorting the materials a toy has been made from. We will explore the suitability of the material also.

RE

In RE we will continue to explore the value of 'belonging' with a focus on Christianity. Later this term we will learn about significant people in the Christian Christmas story.

PSHE/ Thrive

In Thrive we will be exploring how we are all special and unique by describing what we like about each other. We will also talk about taking on responsibilities in the class. In circle time we will continue to practise using our listening skills through a range of games.

We have chosen this topic as the children are keen to share ideas about their favourite toys and, as they have personal experience of this, it will support their imaginative writing.

English

The class will be using the story of Dogger by Shirley Hughes and clips from Toy Story to inspire our writing about a lost toy. We will consolidate our understanding of adjectives to describe our missing toy. Then we will innovate our own story using a story map and explore the feelings of a character using hot seating. We will use adjectives to make our sentences more interesting and we will extend our sentences with 'and' and 'because'. We will also learn how to add '-ed' to a verb. We will continue with daily Read Write Inc sessions to consolidate our knowledge of sounds and learn new sounds too.

Music

In Music we will explore the story of the Nutcracker by Tchaikovsky. Year One will listen to pieces of recorded music and play tuned and un-tuned instruments. Later this term we will learn Christmas songs ready to perform in our Christmas play.
