

Lost and Found

PE will be on Monday and Tuesday. Make sure all items of clothes are clearly named. We have outdoor learning on Thursday afternoons. Please join us at 2.45pm on Monday for family reading this will start on 21.1.19.

We have chosen this topic because the children in Year One are keen to look at maps and explore the world. This will also help the class to be more creative with their own story writing.

English

The class will be reading the story 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers to inspire our writing. We will be writing postcards from the boy to the penguin. Then we will be sequencing the story and creating freeze frames to help us to explore the character's feelings at different points. As a class we will re-tell the story using a story map and actions. We will then use the story map to write our own story. We will also explore similes, adding -ing or -ed to the end of verbs and use words like 'and', 'because' to extend our writing. We will continue with daily Read Write Inc sessions to consolidate our knowledge of sounds and learn new sounds.

Geography

To help us to become geographers we will be using atlases and maps and naming the seas and oceans. We will also be thinking about the route the penguin takes to get to Antarctica naming and comparing hot and cold countries as we go.

Science

To become scientists we will be identifying a variety of common animals including fish, mammals, amphibians, birds and reptiles. Year One will also be describing the characteristics and structure of animals focussing on penguins.

Maths

In Maths we will be learning about time, sequencing events and use language such as today, tomorrow and yesterday.

We will identify one more and one less of a number to 100. The class will then be measuring mass and weight and will look at kilograms and grams.

In Year One we will consolidate our understanding of 2D shapes and describe and sort the properties of triangles, squares, circles and rectangles.

We will continue to practise our number bonds to 20 and doubling and halving numbers.

Art

In Art the class will be exploring 'cool' colours. They will be creating new colours using tint and shade.

Music

To improve our skills as musicians we will listen to a range of live and recorded music from around the world. We will also use percussion instruments to play along with traditional African music.

RE

In RE this term we will be asking the question; 'Who is a Christian and what do they believe?' Through this we will look at the Bible and talk about why it is a special book for Christians.

PSHE/ Thrive

This term we will be thinking about responsibility. The class will be talking about how we can manage our feelings in positive ways. We will also be negotiating rules for the classroom and playground. Year One will also discuss what we should do if we are lost.

Computing

In Year One we will be programming Beebots and learning how to set out simple instructions for the robot to follow. The class will also 'google' maps to help name oceans and countries.

PE.

In outdoor games we will continue to practise sending and receiving a ball with accuracy and control. This half term we will be creating our own dance motifs to music. We will use these to build a whole class dance which we will later perform to the rest of the school.

Outdoor Learning. The class we be exploring the school forest. They will be identifying a range of garden birds and making bird feeders.
