Literacy

The children will be exploring how stories are structured, focusing particularly on characters and settings. We will use various props to create our own stories and think about 'who' will be in our story, 'where' will it take place and 'what' will happen. We also have a wonderful selection of story sacks to explore with the children.

Understanding of the World

The children will be learning about different occupations and ways of life, particularly people who help us. They will learn about different emergency vehicles and use technology to find information and images about our new topic. We will also be learning about how Christians celebrate Easter.

Physical Development

We will be having fun pretending to be superheroes in PE and running, jumping, sliding and hopping to different 'emergencies'. We will also be encouraging the children to become more independent by having races to see who can get dressed up in an outfit the fastest e.g. a firefighter or police officer uniform. To continue developing our fine motor skills we will be making marks in different media such as corn flour and lentils, as well as drawing patterns on emergency vehicles.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will begin the topic by discussing the many different people who help us; how they help and why they help. We will be learning how to resolve conflicts independently e.g. talking to each other and using our manners. For Comic Relief the children will learn about how they can help others.

Maths

The children will be able to explore positional language e.g. under, on top and next to, by either moving themselves or moving a toy. We will also be learning how we can share a group of objects in different ways but the total remains the same.

The children will continue to be encouraged to describe the properties of shapes in their environment e.g. round or tall.

Communication and Language

We will continue with our Marvellous Me boxes to help build confidence when speaking in front of a group and to improve the types of questions we ask. We will also be sequencing pictures to recount an event or activity.

Expressive Arts and Design

We have developed our art and craft area and hope the children will enjoy using the different media available to make their own mini masterpieces. They will then have the opportunity to design and make Mother's Day and Easter cards.
