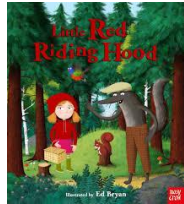

The Enchanted Forest

PE will be on Tuesday and Wednesday. Make sure all items of clothes are clearly named. We have outdoor learning on Thursday afternoon. Please join us at 2.45pm on Monday for Family Reading.

English

During this topic the class will be reading different versions of the traditional tale 'Little Red Riding Hood'. The class will learn the story by sequencing important events and retelling using a story maps and actions. We will then write our own version of the story and change how the wolf is defeated. Through this story we will also look closely at nouns and how adjectives can add detail and how we learn how to use a range of punctuation like question marks and exclamation marks. At the end of the topic Year One will be writing spring poems. We will continue with daily Read Write Inc sessions to consolidate our knowledge of sounds and learn new sounds.

Computing

In Year One we will be using the Ipad to record our own version of the story of Little Red Riding Hood. We will also use the Internet to research woodland animals.

Geography

We will be observing the key features around the school and then use this to create a simple map to follow.

Art

We will be continuing to explore tint and shade and use this to create a whole class collage of a forest. Year One will also use clay to create a small pot.

RE

In RE we will continue to learn about Christianity with a focus on how Christians celebrate Easter.

Outdoor learning

Year One will identify and name common plants and trees found locally and find signs of spring!

Science

To become scientists we will learn the names of woodland animals and label their structures. We will find out about the terms herbivore and carnivores. The class will also be learning about natural and man-made materials and will be describing the physical properties of everyday materials.

Music

As a class we will learn the lyrics to new songs that help us to re-tell the story of Little Red Riding Hood. We will then perform these songs to our peers.

PE.

In outdoor games we will practise skills such as catching, throwing and hitting through cricket led activities. In indoor PE we will explore different ways of travelling along apparatus including; balancing, jumping and rolling.

After a successful visit to Wyre Forest; Year 1 will be reading different versions of Little Red Riding Hood. The class enjoy retelling stories using story maps and actions and we will use this to help inspire creative writing and a 'love of reading'.

Maths

In Maths we will be adding and subtracting 1-digit and 2-digit numbers using a variety of maths apparatus. Then we will use this to help us to solve simple one-step problems including working out missing number problems. The class will be measuring and comparing the length of objects and be introduced to centimetres and metres. We will then be working on multiplication and division using the words; lots of and shared between. In Year One we will continue to practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s forwards and backwards and knowing our doubles and halves of numbers to 20.

PSHE/ Thrive

We will continue to think about responsibility and how our actions affect others. The class will be taking on new roles in the classroom to help us to all look after the equipment. The class will also learn to recognise what is fair and unfair, kind and unkind and what is right and wrong.

History As part of our Pride in Kidderminster week we will be finding out about Sir Rowland Hill and the 'Penny Black'.
