

Topic Web Year 1

Summer Term

Growing



PE will be on Monday and Tuesday. Make sure all items of clothes are clearly named. We have Forest School on Thursday afternoon. Please join us at 2.45pm on Monday for Family Reading.

Maths

In Maths we will describe position, direction and movement, using the vocabulary half, quarter and three-quarter turns. We will also solve practical problems for time using words like earlier, later, quicker and slower and read a clock to the hour and half past the hour. Year One will practise reading and writing numbers in words to 20 and will continue to learn addition and subtraction facts as well as solve problems related to multiplication and division. We will learn the names of 3D shape and learn about capacity.

Design Technology

Year One will be preparing and making a five bean salsa salad. They will also design and make a small garden in a shoe box.

PE

In outdoor PE we will focus on throwing, catching and hitting skills based on simple tennis and cricket games. In indoor PE we will explore different ways of travelling along apparatus including; balancing, jumping and rolling. The class will also be practising athletic activities like running, jumping, throwing in preparation for sports day.

Science

To become scientists we will identify and name common plants and trees found locally and continue to search for signs of spring and summer! Year one will describe the basic structure of plants and plant flowers from seed to observe what happens in the form of a diary. The class will also perform simple tests to show what parts of the plants do.

Art

To become artists Year One will be researching the Artist William Morris. Focussing on observational drawings of plants and flowers and repeating patterns using a range of art materials.

Geography

To become geographers we will be looking at maps of the British Isle, name the countries that make up the UK and use words like countryside, town and city.

Computing

In Year One we will be using the Ipad to record our own version of the story 'Stuck'. We will use cameras to take photos of plants and trees in our forest area and print them ready to label. The class will also learn about Internet safety.

RE

The class will have the opportunity to talk about places that are special to them. We will then explore places that are sacred. We will be focussing on Christianity.

Music

In Music we will listen to 'Spring' by Vivaldi. The class will learn new songs linked to nature and growing and will use percussion instruments. Year One will have the opportunity to perform their song to the rest of the school.

English

We will start our topic with the story Jim and the Beanstalk by Raymond Briggs. The children will be writing a letter from the giant with a focus on extending sentences and, because and spelling key words correctly. Later in the term we will be reading 'Stuck' by Oliver Jeffers. The class will act out the story using props and record a new version on story boards and on an I-pad. The class will continue to use a wider range of adjectives and they will also use a variety of punctuation including exclamation marks. The class will have lots of opportunities to reread their own writing to make sure it makes sense. We will continue with daily Read Write Inc sessions to consolidate our knowledge of sounds and learn new sounds too.

PSHE/ Thrive

This term we will be exploring our feelings and use puppets and drama to express our ideas. We will also practise calming and soothing strategies to help us relax.

The children love to work outdoors and the stories we have chosen will give the class plenty of opportunities to learn outside the classroom and so inspire the children's writing and continue their 'love of reading'.
