Literacy

The children will have many opportunities to mark make as they will be writing about their achievements, making patterns, writing phonemes in phonics and even making their own books. We will continue discussing characters and settings in the stories we share and thinking of alternate endings.

Understanding of the World

As part of our transition we will discuss the changes that happen to us including physical changes such as growing and learning new skills. We will be learning how to build a campfire and stay safe around fire as part of our 'Camping Day'. We will pretend to go on different adventures linked to stories, for example going to space like in the book 'Whatever Next'.

Physical Development

In PE the children will practise a range of games and skills in preparation for sports day. This will include throwing, kicking, balancing, running and working as a team. We will be discussing how to keep our bodies healthy and hope you will all take part in the 'Toothbrushing Challenge'.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

The children will be talking about changes as our older children prepare to move to Reception classes. We will be having several transition times where the children can explore our Reception areas and interact with some of the children. Our younger children will be able to take part too and we will all be discussing what we would like to be/do when we grow up. For our reports we will be talking about our achievements.

Maths

When we pack for our camping day we will encourage the children to work out and then count out how many cups, plates, pieces of fruit, chairs and tents we will need. We will continue estimating and reasoning when having snack and solving problems and we will begin counting how many boys and girls there are each day and adding them together to find the total. We will make tally charts of our favourite things such as food, colours and characters.

Communication and Language

We are going to have a 'Camping Day' in our forest school and so will need to communicate effectively with each other to pack what we will need, prepare food and most importantly put up our tents!

Expressive Arts and Design

To help us improve our gross and fine motor skills we will be making movements to music with our arms and legs (Write Dance) and practising copying different rhythms with instruments. We will also be drawing self-portraits for our end of year reports.
