# Tell me a tale...

### English

To develop as writers, we will continue to build our story telling language skills. We will familiarise ourselves with traditional tale language features and explore stories from different viewpoints. We will look at retelling familiar stories and innovating them. We will explore different character's viewpoints. Furthermore, we will continue to develop our spelling of the Year 2 common exception words.

### Guided reading

To develop as readers, we will be continuing to widen our reading comprehension skills, answering simple inference questions about a text we have read. Furthermore, we will be continuing to develop our fluency of reading, working up to reading 90 words a minute!

### Outdoor Learning

Our outdoor learning will involve finding clues and solving puzzles.

### Design Technology

To develop as designers, we will be designing and making a lift for the princess from The Princess and the Pea. This will involve using a moving mechanism. We will write a set of instructions to accompany our models.

### Music

To develop as musicians, we will use our voices expressively and creatively by singing songs. We will also play tuned and untuned instruments musically. We will combine the two musical elements and perform in a whole school music assembly.

### PE

Outdoor games will involve athletics and practising for our Sports day.

### RE

We will be thinking about how and what we can learn from sacred books.

### PSHE and Thrive

We will be looking at a range of ways to resolve conflict and manage disagreement. We will also be looking at methods of negotiating, collaborating and mediating.

### Science

To develop as scientists, we will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. In addition, we will find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

### Maths

To develop as mathematicians, we will be comparing and sorting common 2D and 3D shapes and everyday objects. We will be revising telling the time as well as comparing and sequencing time intervals. In addition to this, we will be revising our knowledge and understanding of multiplication and division facts. We will be asking and answering questions about data. Furthermore, we will be finding different combinations of coins that equal the same amounts of money. Arithmetic sessions will enable us to improve our recall of basic number facts, including multiplication facts.

**In addition to children's half-termly home learning, we expect children to be reading daily, which should be recorded in diaries. Children also need to practise their recall of multiplication facts, using Timestables Rock Stars.**
