




Sutton Park Primary RSA Academy- Year 3

Where would be a good place to settle?

English

In English we will be using the text 'A Bear Called Paddington.' They will use this to write a persuasive letter home to Aunt Lucy describing what Paddington has found out about London. All areas of punctuation and grammar will be covered through this text.



KASE

Our curriculum is designed to ensure the children build their knowledge whilst having opportunities to develop important attributes like teamwork and empathy. We plan for a clear progression of skills and provide a wealth of experiences to further their engagement and understanding. We therefore call this our KASE curriculum.

Geography

The children will learn about the four countries that make up the United Kingdom. They will also find out about the capital cities and be able to locate them on a map. As well as learning about the countries themselves the children will also study the physical geography looking at rivers and mountain ranges within Britain.

PSHE

Pupils will learn about celebrating achievements and setting personal goals; about dealing with put-downs and about positive ways to deal with set-backs.

Mathematics

In Maths this half term the children will be focussing on measure, learning about length, mass and volume. We will also be studying the formal methods for multiplication and division.

The children will be working on using and applying the skills they have learnt in a variety of practical situations.

Mental maths lessons will also be taught each week working on basic number skills.

DT

In DT the children will be making 3D topographical maps. These will show all the aspects we have covered in geography such as capital cities, key rivers and mountains.

RE

This half term we will be focusing on what different people believe about God. We shall link it to different religions.

Rationale: This topic builds upon the work the children have already done with Stone Age settlers. Through an enquiry-based approach the children will explore areas of the UK and make decisions about where the most suitable place to settle could be and why.

Science

In Science this half term the children will be learning about forces and magnets.

PE

The children will have PE on a Tuesday and Friday afternoon. We will be studying netball and dance from the UK. Please have your PE kit in school.

Thrive

We will be exploring how to respond appropriately in unfamiliar situations. We will also be learning how to tackle feelings of anxiety.

French

Through songs, games and conversation the children will learn the days and months. They will also learn the names of family members.
