Maths Task

Can you start by playing the game 'Hit the Button'

Write down the numbers 30-50. Can you find the number that comes after 39? Find the number that comes after 45. Find the number that comes before 50. What is 1 more than 31? What is 1 more than 49? Can you tell your grown ups anything else about these numbers? Then have a go at writing numbers 50-70 and ask similar questions.

Foundation Subject Task

Today we are going to do some science. Tell your grown up what you know about grouping animals. Can you name some animals that are; reptiles, amphibians, mammals, birds, fish? Make a list. If you log on to education city you can play 'A bite to Eat' and 'Animal Detective'. (Click on subjects→science→Year One)
