**Maths Task**

Can you start by playing the game 'Hit the Button'

<https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button> try out some number bonds, Start with number bonds to 10 and as a challenge you could try to 20. 'How speedy can you be?'

You can use objects at home (e.g. lego bricks) to make number bonds to 10 then to 20. How many different ways can you make 10 (e.g. 5+5, 3+7 etc.) then as a challenge try making 20 in lots of different ways.

**Foundation Subject Task**

Today we are going to do some science. Tell your grown up what you know about chocolate. What happens to chocolate when it is heated? (ask a grown up to help you or place some in the sun). What happens to chocolate when it is cooled? (put it in the fridge). Can you explain why this happens?

I hope that you enjoy completing today's tasks. With your grownups help you might like to send me a photo as proof of you finishing your work, or write an email explaining how well the task went. You do not need to do this for every task, once or twice a week would be enough.
