English Task

Building on yesterday's task, we are going to be using our Mars Rover designs. You now officially work for the UK Space Agency. You need to explain to them how your Rover works, so that they can decide which Rover will be the best to send to Mars. All you need to do today is write the introduction of your explanation. Remember, you need a question as a title, use rhetorical questions to interest your audience and consider the technical vocabulary you can include. Think back to the work we did last week to help you!

Maths Task

Today, I would like you to further demonstrate your knowledge of shape with a focus on 3d shape. Look around your house and see if you can find 3d shapes, making sure you can identify the names of the 3d shapes that you find. You could then begin to think about what the net would look like for those shapes and draw them. Don't forget to also record the properties of the shape you have chosen. If you have the resources available, you could select an object and try to make a box for it by drawing the net and making it.

Foundation Subject Task

Today you are going to have a go at some computing! Head to the [Hour of Code](#) website. When you get there, the first task you see is called 'Dance Party'. Have a go at trying to code a dance party!

If you do not have internet access, then create your own dance party! Choose your favourite song and create a dance to it – make sure you write down your 'code' (instructions) to your dance so that it can be taught to others!
