Make sure you keep a record of some of these throughout the week either through photos or as written work. Remember, you don't need to do this every day, one or two times a week would be great.

English Task

Watch the following YouTube clip: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=dY_3ggKg0Bc
The first time, just watch it and take it all in. On your second watch, collect vocabulary to describe the changing scene. Once you have collected your vocabulary, have a go at up levelling them. Include words to describe senses (hear, see, smell, feel). Write as many sentences as you can using the words you have come up with. Try and include fronted adverbials, expanded noun phrases and subordinate clauses. We will be using these sentences for tomorrow's English task so make sure you keep them safe.

Maths Task

For today's task, I would like you to begin to create a board game with a focus on multiplication and division calculations. You could also include factors. Your board game can take on any style you like and could be based on a board game you like e.g. Monopoly. Today, you need to come up with the design of your board game and how it will be played. You will need to think about what resources you will need. Will you need to create question cards? How will it be played? Do you need counters and dice? Will you have a points system? Will some questions be harder than others? What will your board game be called? Start planning!

Foundation Subject Task

For today's task, I would like you to investigate the human digestive system. Watch the video <https://www.dailymotion.com/video/x6tx7y5> and collect notes about the different stages of digestion including the names of the organs and parts and how they work. I have also saved some work on Education city in the 'classwork' section for you to do. Once you have done this, create a poster or information booklet about how the digestive system works. If you want to, you could make your poster interactive with flaps to lift up or make a model of the digestive system.
