Once you have read, scroll down to the box titled, 'Question time!' and have a go at answering the questions. Next, you can work through the 'Sentence challenge!' section. Once you have done this, have a go at writing a poem about a volcanic eruption. You could use some of the words you came across today. Maths Task

Log in to Sumdog (www.sumdog.com) and click on the 'Tasks' tab on the left hand side of the screen. Here you will see a range of 'training' activities. At the very top there will be a section named 'Maths 30.03.20'. Click on that and work your way through the activities set. There are a range of challenges to complete. If you reach the target score, you get 50 coins! Once you have completed this, create a poster or booklet that shows everything you know about subtraction. This could be vocabulary related to subtraction, number sentences, word problems, maybe you could even try writing your own problems or reasoning tasks for your grown ups to solve!

This week, I am going to set you a mini project to do. Each day you will have certain tasks to complete within it. I would like you to create your own country. Today, I need you to design what the country will look like on a map, the name of the country, its flag and where it would sit in the World today.
