English Task

Consider the words you might use to do this. How will you make your argument strong? Why should they allow you to do this? What are they going to gain from your country? Look at the countries around yours to get some idea of what yours will be like. Once you have done this, think about what the main language is. Can you find out any key phrases which might be useful to know for someone visiting your country for the first time? If you are feeling imaginative and want to create your own language, go ahead!
