English Task

Think of someone who is really special to you, it could be a friend or a family member. Can you draw a picture of them and talk to a grown-up about why they are special to you. Then see if you can write a sentence about them, remember to use your finger spaces in between words and also to try and order the sounds in each word by 'Fred-talking' it e.g. 'hug' = 'h-u-g'

If you would like to listen to a Read Write Inc. phonics session, Read write Inc. are uploading free phonics sessions, with a new sound being added each day. They are available via YouTube where you can view set 1 and set 2 sound sessions. I wonder if you can follow along and write any of the sounds down.
