English Task

Share a book or listen to a story. There are some lovely stories to listen to on the cbeebies website. <https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/stories?page=2>

Talk about what happened in the story. Who were the main characters? Can you re-tell the story. Create a story map of the story by drawing a picture and then arrows to show what happens next. Your maps could look something like this:



Phonics: If you are able to search Ruth Miskin Training on You Tube or on Facebook. Try out the lessons that focus on set 2 and set 3 sounds. If not can you think of words with the igh sound (high) or ie (pie) and make a list.

Maths Task

Start with this game to practise numbers that add to make 10. If you can not access this site, write the numbers that add together to make 10 e.g. $10+0=10$, $9+1=10$ and so on.

Using the number names in words from yesterdays task, roll a dice to make up an addition write the answer in words. For example

If you roll a 5 then a 4 write $5+4 = \text{nine}$

How many can you write in 2 minutes.

You could draw or paint a picture of a daffodil to add to your diary. You could label the daffodil- Petal, stem, leaves, root.
