English Task

Phonics: If you are able to search Ruth Miskin Training on You Tube or on Facebook. Try out the lessons that focus on set 2 and set 3 sounds. If not can you think of words with the sound ar (as in car) and or (as in for) make a list of these words.

This week we will be using the story; Jack and the Beanstalk. (Jack and the Beanstalk, Oxbridge baby on YouTube is a good version of the story.) Can you re-tell the story. Who are the main characters? What happens at the beginning? What happens at the end? Have a go at acting out the story.

Maths Task


