Maths Task

Your challenge: How much do you know about your favourite number?

What to do:

1. What's your favourite number? Write it down in the centre of a piece of paper (if you don't have a favourite number, choose one at random or ask a family member for theirs.)
2. Note down **at least** 20 facts around your number, creating a poster. Examples you could choose include even/odd, sides on a shape, which tables it is in, which calculations create that number, number of animal legs which total that number etc

Try to make sure you have a good range of different types of facts and be as creative as you can with how you present your work.

Foundation Subject Task
