**English Task**

Try to practise your phonics daily with Read Write Inc sessions on You Tube or you could play a phonics game on [www.phonicsplay.co.uk](http://www.phonicsplay.co.uk). Also remember to try reading for 10-20 minutes each day. You can do this at any time of the day – morning, afternoon or at bedtime! Today I would like you to write a short character description for either a nurse or a doctor. (YR's colour picture page 6 and record a sentence please). Don't forget that in a character description you need to describe what they would wear, what they do, equipment they may use, where they would work. Also, you would need to describe some of the qualities they would need e.g. kind, brave, helpful, thoughtful, etc. Don't forget to write why they are helpful or kind etc. using the conjunction 'because'. If you would like to do one of these jobs when you are older you could write that too or give your opinion as to what you think about nurses and doctors at the moment.

**Maths Task** Today Y2's/ Y4's please start by practising your timestables on [www.trockstars.com](http://www.trockstars.com). YR's/ Y1's please practise counting in 10's from 0 to 100 again.

Today we are going to practise adding coin values again using the game 'Coins Game' <https://www.topmarks.co.uk/money/coins-game>. Choose British currency (British flag) and 'Counting'. YR's can start 'single coins to 10p/ and Y1's start at '1p to 10p', Y2's/Y4's start at '4 coins to 20p/ any 5 coins'. If the task is too tricky try an easier level and if it is too easy then challenge yourself to a harder level. Remember you can always play this game with real coins (if you cannot get online) – ask a grown up to give you amounts and see if you can add the values.

**Foundation Subject Task**

Today I would like you to do some History. Before the Easter holiday we thought about a famous lady from the past who was a nurse. Her name was Florence Nightingale. I have an animation for you to watch about her today <https://www.twinkl.co.uk/go/resource/meet-florence-nightingale-animation-tg-a-34-1> and if you get chance to work with a grown-up you could also read the attached powerpoint and complete the activities in the powerpoint which compares hospitals and nursing from the past (then) with today (now).
