English Task

For today's 100 word challenge, your stimulus is the following words:

bag black heavy jumped damaged

You can use them in any order but ALL of them must be included in your work. If you are finding fitting it into 100 words too tricky, up your word allowance to 150. Remember, you can write a story, a poem or a non-fiction task. Use your imagination!

Maths Task

Your challenge: Can you make a larger five-digit number than your partner?

How to play: **1.** Get your digit cards ready. Make these using scraps of paper and using the digits 0-9) **2.** Shuffle all three sets of the digit cards. You and your partner must each draw five big lines on your sheet of paper like this: _____ **3.** Take it in turns to turn over a digit card and decide where in your number you are going to place the digit. **4.** Put the digit in that position and tell your partner what value that digit has. For example, if you put a 4 in the tens column, you would say 'this 4 is worth 4 tens or forty'. **5.** Once you have placed a digit in your number, you can't move it! Therefore, it's important to think about the strategy you are using. Play at least six rounds. Who will be the champion? Have fun! 😊

Foundation Subject Task
