English Task

Phonics: If you are able to search Ruth Miskin Training on You Tube or on Facebook, try out the lessons that focus on set 2 and set 3 sounds. If not can you think of words with the sound air (as in fair) and ir (as bird) make a list of these words. Choose 3 words from each list to write in a sentence.

Writing: Today we would like you to talk about writing a letter. Imagine Jack would like to write a letter to say sorry to the giant for stealing his things. Think about what you would include in the letter for example; Why is he sorry, why he stole the items and what he did with them, what could he do to make it up to the giant? Also think about how to start a letter should start (Dear...) and how it should end (From ...) Thursday and Friday tasks will be to write the letter!

Maths Task

Today we would like you to start with number pairs. Have a try at this game... <https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button> and click on number bonds. Try out; make 10 and for an extra challenge select make 20, make 100.

Thinking about measuring; What else can you measure the length of around the house? Select 5 different house old objects and put them in order from the longest to the shortest. Can you say a sentence about each object? For example; The pencil is **longer** than the spoon but **shorter** than the broom. Try and use the words longer than, shorter than, longest and shortest.

Foundation Subject Task

Art: Today we would like you to make a collage of a flowering plant. You could use any scraps of paper or you use paint, crayons, chalk, felt tips. Don't forget to label your collage afterwards.
