**English Task**

Try to practise your phonics daily with Read Write Inc sessions on You Tube or you could play a phonics game on [www.phonicsplay.co.uk](http://www.phonicsplay.co.uk). Also remember to try reading for 10-20 minutes each day. You can do this at any time of the day and anywhere – the kitchen, garden, bedroom!

Today I would like you to think about another group of people who help us. These are refuse collectors (we often call them 'binmen'). They collect and take away our rubbish and recycling. Today you might like to colour and 'Thankyou poster' for them and stick it to your dustbin or recycling bin or put it in your window so they can see it when they collect your rubbish. I am sure it will make them smile! If you can print off 'Thankyou Keyworkers poster' use p17, p18 or p19 to help you or create your own.

**Maths Task**

I would like everyone to start by playing the 'faster finger coin' powerpoint game attached with the planning. It is lots of fun. You could challenge a grown up or brother or sister!

Today we are going to practise combining coins to make an amount using 'Combination of coins' activity sheets. Start on page 1 and 2 and if you find these easy then challenge yourself to the next worksheets pages 3+.

Remember that you can use real coins to help you. If you cannot print off these worksheets you can use real coins and ask a grown up to set you an amount to make e.g. 'Can you make 14p?' Remember to look at the value of each coin and use your fingers or draw/count dots for each value to help if you need to.
