magic contact



Choose some containers from around your house. Using smaller objects, for example Lego bricks, estimate how many the container will hold. Then fill the container with your chosen objects. Compare the amount with your estimation. Try it for 5 different sized containers. Record your findings.



Foundation Subject Task

For this task, you will have today and tomorrow to complete it. Using all of your knowledge of the United Kingdom, create a game that will test your family's knowledge and understanding of the UK. You could base it on a familiar game, like Snakes and Ladders: When someone lands on a ladder, they could answer a question before they are allowed up it; for example, Name the 4 countries of the United Kingdom. What is the capital of England? What is the English flag called?
