English Task

For today's 100-word challenge, your stimulus is this piece of [music](#). It is titled, 'The letter that never came'. First, listen to the music. What words, feelings, pictures come to your mind? Make a list of them. Once you have done that, your challenge is to create a piece of writing with the same title as the music: The letter that never came. Who could be waiting to receive the letter? What might be inside? Is the person waiting for the letter? How do they feel? What might happen if they never receive it? Remember, this could be a story or a poem. It could even be song lyrics. Be as imaginative as you can. Good luck!

Maths Task

One-handed Maths, Paper, Scissors!

Your challenge: Have you ever played 'Rock, Paper, Scissors'? Well this is a maths version of the same game! How to play: **1.** Stand and face your partner. Make one fist and say together with your partner 'maths, paper, scissors' whilst moving your fists up and down (in a similar way to when playing rock, paper, scissors). **2.** On scissors, each of you puts out between 1 and 5 fingers. **3.** You then need to race to multiply the number of fingers you have put out by the number of fingers your partner put out (e.g. 3 x 1) and call out the answer. **4.** The player to call the correct answer first, wins a point. **5.** Record who wins each 'battle' in a simple table; the first player to 20 points wins! You can make this harder by using all 10 fingers!

Foundation Subject Task

Today's task is an art one! Use this clip to follow the instructions given by the illustrator, Steven Lenton to draw a character from the book, 'The Nothing To See Here Hotel'. It might be worth watching the [video](#) first, then have a go! You can pause at each section and take your time to get it right, there's no need to rush.
