English Task

Spelling: **come, some, one, once**

Pick one of these words; how many times can you write it in 20 seconds? Try writing this word in a sentence.

Writing – Today we would like you to begin writing your letter from Jack to the Giant to say sorry. Hopefully you will have planned this yesterday. If not don't panic, you will need to include why Jack is sorry, what did he steal and what did he do with these items? Also include a sentence to say how Jack could make it up to the Giant to say sorry. Remember to start your letter with Dear Giant, and end with love from Jack.

Maths Task

Mental warm up – Play '**Alien Addition**'. - <https://www.arcademics.com/games/alien>

Here you need to shoot the alien spaceships which have the correct addition sum to match the answer. Choose your own name for the leader board and have fun!!

Measuring – Could you find a shoe from each member of your family and line them up in order starting with the shortest and ending with the longest. Could you find a method of measuring each shoe? e.g. using lego cubes, paper clips or even coins. How many items is each shoe? Remember to start at the heel of the shoe and measure up until the toe and stop counting.

Foundation Subject Task

For today and tomorrow sessions we are going to learn a song about growing and create our own actions ready to perform to entertain our families!
