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Welcome Comment

Good morning Language Class. Here are your activities for today. Keep up the super work! Have a lovely weekend.

English Task Try to practise your phonics daily with Read Write Inc sessions on You Tube or you could play a phonics game on www.phonicsplay.co.uk. Also remember to try reading for 10-20 minutes each day. I have sent you a list of Year1 and Year 2 spellings. You can start by practising a few each day. Can you write a sentence with a spelling word in it?

Today we are continuing to think about 'People Who Help Us'. Can you dress up today as someone who helps us? You may have some dressing up clothes (e.g. fireman, doctor) or you may use everyday clothes (shop assistant with till point and food!) Can you discuss with a grown up who you are dressed as and why it is so important for you to be doing that job at the moment? I would love to see a photo and see if I can guess who you are pretending to be! Then discuss the following: 'At the moment it is more important to be working as a film star or pop star (than as a nurse or doctor)'. Discuss and explain using the phrases we use at school 'I agree because....' Or 'I disagree because'.

Maths Task

We are all going to start today by counting again in different steps (1's, 2's, 5's, 10's). This will help when you are counting coins of the same value e.g. 10p, 20p, 30p etc. Use <https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/supermoovers/ks1-maths-counting-with-john-farnworth/zbct8xs>. You all know this song – you could teach it to someone in your family!

Today we are going to try some problem solving activities using money. Get some real coins nearby to help you. Play 'Maths Money' powerpoint. You may need a grown up to help you read the questions. You can do this!

Foundation Subject Task

Today we are going to continue with our Science - thinking about different materials and recycling. Can you remember what recycling means from the powerpoint yesterday? Have fun sorting the recycling of different materials in this online game.
