### English Task

Firstly, I would like you to read some instructions (these could be from a game or recipe). Can you spot any **imperative verbs**? Make a list of these.

Next, look at the picture below: First flight. In the picture, the older owl is giving instructions to the younger owl about how to fly.



Think of an activity that you like to do, such as scoring a goal in football or helping to make a sandwich at lunch time. Give instructions to an adult. (Do not write these down yet!) Think about breaking the instructions into smaller steps and consider the use of imperative verbs (bossy verbs).


An **imperative verb** is one that tells someone to do something, so that the sentence it is in becomes an order or command. E.g. Wash your hands!

### Maths Task

#### Fractions

Show the fractions. You can use objects from around your house or simply draw diagrams. Make sure you have **EQUAL** parts.



**1 = one whole**       **$\frac{3}{4}$  = three quarters**

**$\frac{1}{2}$  = one half**       **$\frac{1}{3}$  = one third**

**$\frac{1}{4}$  = one quarter**       **$\frac{2}{3}$  = two thirds**

**$\frac{2}{4}$  = two quarters**

### Foundation Subject Task

This week, we are going to be considering keeping safe indoors and outdoors. Create some rules for keeping safe indoors and outdoors. You could write and illustrate your ideas.
