Today Y2's/ Y4's please start by practising your timestables on www.ttrockstars.com. YR's/ Y1's please practise counting in 2's from 0 to 20.

Today you will need 10p (made from 10 x 1p coins). Practically, can you work out how much change you would have (how much money left) if you bought items that cost a) 5p? b) 2p? c) 3p? d) 8p? e) 2p? f) 6p g) 7p h) 10p. Use the 1p coins so you can see how much is left when you take away the cost. With the help of a grownup try recording the number sentences e.g. a) $10p - 5p = 5p$

Today I would like you to do some Art by creating a portrait using natural materials that you might find in your garden or on a walk e.g. twigs, leaves, stones, petals etc. Who are you going to create?
