- 1.) On page 11, the bus driver tells Stanley to be careful. How could this, 'Be careful' be interpreted? What might the bus driver mean?
- 2.) "He was also given white sneakers, an orange cap, and a canteen made of heavy plastic, which unfortunately was empty." This book is written by an American author, so some of the words might be unfamiliar. What are sneakers? What is a canteen?
- 3.) Why do you think Mr Pendanski insists on using the boys' proper names instead of their nicknames?
- 4.) Mr Pendanski says, "You may have done some bad things, but that doesn't mean you're a bad kid". What do you think about this statement? Do you agree? Explain your thinking.
- 5.) At the bottom of page 17, Mr Pendanski says, "Lewis is still in the hospital...He won't be returning." What effect does this sentence have on the reader? Why? What do you think has happened to Barf Bag?

### **Maths Task**

We are carrying on with our work on decimals today looking at adding decimals with a different number of decimal places. [Summer week 2, lesson 3](#)  
The important thing to remember for this, is that when you are using column addition and the numbers you are adding don't have the same number of decimal places – use your place holding zeros to help you! Q 1 – 5, use column addition to help you – make sure you line up your decimal points carefully! Q 6 – read the question carefully and then show your working out! Questions 7, 8 and 9 are our challenge questions today. Have a go, but don't worry if you are finding them tricky! Good luck ☺
