### **English Task**

### **Maths Task**

Try out; make 10 and for an extra challenge select make 20, make 100. (You can also use your number line- circle a number e.g. 3 and count on to make 10 repeat with other numbers. Then circle a number e.g. 12 and count on to make 20 repeat with other numbers.)
