You could try and write sentences about different people that you know are helping us at the moment. E.g. 'The refuse collectors come once a week to take away our rubbish'.

**Maths Task** Today Y2's/ Y4's please start by practising your timestables on [www.trockstars.com](http://www.trockstars.com). YR's/ Y1's please practise counting in 2's from 0 to 20.

We are going to finish our current Maths topic of money by playing the following games. Please have a go at 'Custom Car Garage' and use coins to create your own car on <https://www.ictgames.com/mobilePage/customCars/index.html> start on level 1 and increase the difficulty as appropriate.

Then try some problem solving using <https://www.topmarks.co.uk/Flash.aspx?f=Buy2itemsv4>. This is a little more challenging, but I know you can do it!

**Foundation Subject Task** Today I would like you to play a Speech and Language game thinking about naming items in a category. Roll your 0-9 dice (from your resource pack), whatever number you roll then choose the corresponding question below. This is a fun game to play with your family. Maybe you could award a counter for each one you get correct and then see who has the most counters at the end?

1. Name 5 things that you would see in the sea.
2. Name 5 boys names.
3. Name 5 things that feel soft.
4. Name 5 things you would see on a beach.
5. Name 5 things that are cold.
6. Name 5 things that can fly.
7. Name 5 things that you would see on a farm.
8. Name 5 things that are rectangular.
9. Name 5 fruits.

You can make this more challenging by thinking of more things in each group. Why not think of your own questions too?
