English Task Remember to practise your phonics daily with Read Write Inc sessions on You Tube. I know some of you have also joined in the Read Write Inc spelling sessions. Well Done! Please try reading for 10-20 minutes each day. Are you ready to move on to the next 5 spellings on your spelling list?

On Friday it is a Bank Holiday because it will be 75 years since VE Day (a special day when there were celebrations and parties during World War Two). We will be learning about this and completing some activities related to this for the rest of the week. If you can please take a look at the attached powerpoint 'VE Day 75th Anniversary' today. You will need a grown up to help you with some of the tricky words and to talk about what it means. You may even be planning to celebrate VE Day on Friday with your own house/garden party. Maths Task Everyone start by learning and singing this number bonds song today <https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/supermovers/ks1-maths-number-bonds-with-martin-dougan/zf6cpg8>

This week we are thinking about addition of two numbers and using the + and = symbols. Watch <https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zwv39j6/articles/z8hyfrd> and complete the activities that follow it.

Then using your dice from your resources pack create some addition number sentences.

1. Roll the dice once and record the number e.g. 5.
2. Then record the add symbol (+) e.g. 5+.
3. Next roll the dice again and record that number too e.g. 5+6.
4. Then record the equals symbol e.g. 5+6=.

Well done. You have created a number sentence. Now calculate the answer! Repeat so you have completed 10 number sentences. If you want a challenge get a grown up to give you a larger number (2 or 3 digits) as your first number.

Foundation Subject Task

Mrs Fassnidge has set a family Art challenge for you today. The challenge is to recreate a famous piece of art work. This can be achieved by using whatever resources you have around your home. You could use paint, pencils, chalk, real life objects or even yourself. All you really need to do is use your imagination and make sure that your recreation contains a twist!
