
**Keep your picture of Farmer Duck ready for tomorrow's activity.**

**Maths Task** - For today's task you will need to collect your whiteboard, whiteboard pen and your 10 counters from your school pack.

Today we are going to find half of a number. Ask a grown up to help you draw 3 boxes on your whiteboard like this.

Place 4 counters in the big box and then share the counters into the smaller boxes equally.

Remember to find half, the number of counters in both boxes MUST be the same!
