Good morning Language Class. Here are your activities for today. Please do what you can and don't worry too much if tasks don't get completed. You are all doing a fantastic job. English Task Remember to practise your phonics daily with Read Write Inc sessions on You Tube. Please try reading for 10-20 minutes each day. Why not try reading in the dark with a torch, or in the sun wearing sunglasses, or make a reading den! Keep practising your spellings too!

This week we are thinking about the VE Day celebrations that took place near the end of World War Two 75 years ago (and why we have a Bank Holiday on Friday). So today I want you are to be code breakers! During the war, messages were sent to soldiers using morse code. It uses dots and dashes (lines) for different letters of the alphabet and numbers. Please print out the attached 'Mores Code' worksheets. Use the chart on page 2 to try and work out the secret messages on pages 3 and 4 (tomorrow we will try pages 5 and 6!). If you can't print out the worksheets have a go at making up your own code for the letters of the alphabet. Good Luck code breakers!

YR's try repeating the task from yesterday. Can you calculate the answers using your counters, number line or even in your head!
