Good morning Year 2!


The Three Bear Chair challenge is proving successful; I'm thoroughly enjoying seeing your creativity this week. Keep up the super work Year 2!

### Maths Task

To begin, I would like you to Log in to Times Tables Rockstar's <https://trockstars.com/> and complete work on your times tables for 10 minutes.

#### Mental Addition

**Start at zero.** Record it at the bottom of your paper. Roll the die. Add the number shown. Continue adding until you reach as close to 50 as possible. **Challenge yourself by reaching 100.** Again, you could challenge a family member. Repeat the activity to improve your pace.



### Foundation Subject Task

**Day 3 of your task.** You have been asked by the Three Bears to make a new set of chairs for them. The chairs must be strong enough to hold 1kg (a bag of sugar). You must choose different materials to the ones you have already chosen. **Today's chair will be for Baby Bear.** Baby bear is only small, so it has to be no more than 5 cm off the ground. Get creating and test out your model!

**Keep your models safe; next week I will set you a task relating to this week's work. It will be on Tuesday's planning as there will be a family challenge on Monday's.**
