You will need this for tomorrow's activity.

This week we are continuing to think about addition and subtraction. Today **Y1**'s have a look at the video <https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-1/> (Summer Term, Week 4) lesson 1 – Add by making 10. Record your own number sentences following the videoclip.

Y2's look at the video <https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2> (Summer Term, Week 4) lesson 1 – Adding and Subtracting Tens. Record your own number sentences following the videoclip.

YR's – You need your dice today and a coin with '+' taped to one side and '-' taped to the other. Create a number sentence by rolling the dice twice and tossing the coin e.g. $6+5=$ then write your number sentence. Remember the largest number needs to go first if it is take away! Now calculate the answer! Don't get mixed up between '+' and '-'!

Foundation Subject Task

Miss McGowan has set a family Music challenge for you this week. The challenge is for your family to become musicians and to create an orchestra or band! This can be achieved by using whatever resources you have around your home. You could use pots and pans, pencils and twigs, the hoover, any suitable and safe household objects or even yourself to make interesting sounds!
