English Task



Submarines were used by lots of countries during WW2 (World War Two). They used sonar to detect objects and other presences around them such as allies, enemies and dangerous water mines which are underwater bombs. The image shows an area of ocean on a sonar screen. It shows the centre of the area and the distance the water mines are from the centre.

Questions: 1. How many mines were more than 10m away from the centre? 2. What fraction of mines are further than 10m from the centre?
