If 'The Wolf' is the answer, what is the question?

I would like you to think about 8 questions that could have the answer, 'The Wolf' e.g. who stopped Little Red Riding Hood when she was walking through the forest?

Remember to include capital letters and question marks!

Maths Task

To begin, I would like you to log in to Times Tables Rockstar's <https://trockstars.com/> and complete work on your times tables for 10 minutes.

Mental Addition: adding multiples of 10 to 2-digit numbers

Roll your die 2 times. Record as a 2-digit number. Make eight 2-digit numbers.

Now add 30 to each number, recording a number sentence:

$54 + 30 = 84$.

Repeat, adding 40 and 50 to your eight 2-digit numbers.

Challenge yourself by making and using 3-digit numbers.

Remember:

The ones digit stays the same, but the tens/hundreds digit changes.

Foundation Subject Task

Last week, you had been busy designing and making chairs for the Three Bears. Evaluate your work, considering the following questions: How successful were your models? What worked well? Which was the strongest chair? How do you know? Did you need to make any improvements? If so, what were these?

You may wish to draw pictures with annotations; print photographs and annotate or simply write down your thoughts.
