Good morning Language Class. Keep up the fantastic work! Here are your activities for today.

**English Task** Please practise your phonics daily with Read Write Inc sessions on You Tube. You could have a go at Read Write Inc spelling sessions on You Tube too. Please try reading for 10-20 minutes each day.

Please practice your next 5 spellings and write a sentence with each spelling in. Your sentences can be as creative and as funny as you want!

Our new mini topic is all about 'Trains'. Today I would like you to make some train puppets using the attached worksheet. If you cannot print this out, then you can draw your own trains instead. Tape each character to a lollipop stick or straw if you have one. Name each character and think about where they may travel and what they may say to other trains as they pass! We will be using these ideas tomorrow. Can you think of any stories you know or films you have watched that have a train in them?

**Maths Task**

Today Y2's/ Y4's please start by practising your timestables on [www.trockstars.com](http://www.trockstars.com). YR's/ Y1's please practise writing your numbers correctly. Start 0-20 and then try 0-50 (or even 100!)

Today have a go at the game 'Subtraction Grids'. Choose 'one number' and then move through the levels. <https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/subtraction-grids> You can use a number line if needed but some of you will be able to work these out quickly in your head.

As an extra task why don't you be the teacher again today and write your own missing number sentences for a grown up to do. You could have 5 addition sentences and 5 subtraction sentences. Make sure you know the answers so you can mark their work and explain the mistake if they get it wrong!

**Foundation Subject Task**

Today I would like you to do some D.T. Can you use items (e.g. empty packets and boxes, empty kitchen roll tubes etc) or lego or toy bricks to build a train model? You can add carriages too if you want! You could also make a train station and use your puppets (made in English) to act out what the train characters may say to each other!

**Any Further Guidance**
