Maths Task

To begin, I would like you to log in to Times Tables Rockstar's <https://trockstars.com/> and complete work on your times tables for 10 minutes.

Mental Subtraction: using known facts.


Record all the multiples of 10 (the number we get after multiplying by 10). Choose 2 of the multiples of 10. Subtract the smaller multiple from the larger one, recording a number sentence:

50 - 30 = 20 (I know that 5 - 3 = 2).

Record at least 15 calculations.

Have a go at recreating your map from yesterday's task. Today, however, I would like you to recreate it using real-life objects to represent different parts of the forest. You need some space to be able to carry out this activity, so you could try it in the garden. Guide a member of your family through the 'forest' without them touching any of the 'obstacles'.
