### Welcome Comment

Good morning Language Class. Here are your activities for the day.

**English Task** Remember to practise your phonics daily with Read Write Inc reading and spelling sessions on You Tube. Please try reading for 10-20 minutes each day.

Today we are going to think about ideas to create a 'problem' part of a story. Imagine that your train character goes into a tunnel.....but then does not come out the other side! What could have happened to it? (e.g. fell into a hole, broke down, found a secret tunnel or cave inside, time travel, train robbery etc.) Share your ideas with a grown up. Write down key words (you can practice spelling or check in a dictionary), that you might need.



We are going to write part of this story tomorrow.

**Maths Task** Everyone start by playing 'Maths Fishing' again. **Y1**'s and **YR**'s start with doubles and **Y2**'s practise your times tables at <https://mathsframe.co.uk/en/resources/resource/306/Maths-Fishing-Multiplication>

This week we are thinking about multiplication and division. **YR**'s and **Y1**'s please take a look at grouping and sharing by playing 'Karate Kids'. **Y2/4**'s use your dice and 3 number cards (2, 5, 10) to create multiplication sentences. Write number 2, 5 and 10 on 3 separate cards then mix them up and turn them over so you cannot see them.

1. Roll dice and record number e.g. 6x
2. Choose and turn over a number card and record in number sentence e.g. 6x5=
3. Complete multiplication number sentence e.g. 6x5=30

If you are confident with your 3 and 4 x times tables you can use number cards for these too. As your dice only goes up to 9 you may want to challenge yourself by creating extra number sentences using 10, 11 and 12 for your 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

### Foundation Subject Task

This week is Mental Health Awareness week. This year's theme is 'kindness'. Today I would like you to show kindness to your family by asking your parents for a chore that would really help them out. It might be something like washing up, tidying your toys, weeding in the garden or making everyone a drink. Have fun showing how kind you are!
