Good morning Language Class. Here are your activities for the day.

English Task Remember to practise your phonics daily with Read Write Inc reading and spelling sessions on You Tube. Please try reading for 10-20 minutes each day.

Today we are going to write the 'problem' part of your own story that you thought about yesterday. Imagine that your train character goes into a tunnel.....but then does not come out the other side! What could have happened to it? (e.g. fell into a hole, broke down, found a secret tunnel or cave inside, time travel, train robbery etc.) Remember to say each sentence out loud before you write it. Please start writing using the sentence starter 'The train thundered into the dark, eerie tunnel and then all was quiet.....' You do not need to write too much – a few paragraphs of good writing will be fantastic. Don't forget to use full stops, capital letters and order your story correctly. Try and make it exciting and read it to your family, can they predict what has happened?

Maths Task

Everyone start by playing 'Maths Fishing' again. **Y1**'s and **YR**'s start with doubles and **Y2**'s practise your times tables at <https://mathsframe.co.uk/en/resources/resource/306/Maths-Fishing-Multiplication>

Today **Y2/4**'s look at <https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2> (Summer Term, Week 5) lesson 2 – Using arrays. Watch the video and complete the activities in the video today and tomorrow we will do some more work on using arrays for multiplication. What is an array? Can you describe what it is following your work today?

YR's and **Y1**'s please complete the attached activity 'Steam train themed ordering 1'. Can you order the steam trains in size and then use key words to describe to a grown up e.g. biggest/ bigger/ smallest/ smaller? You may even be able to use length (longer) and height (taller) to compare different steam trains.

Foundation Subject Task

This week is Mental Health Awareness week. This year's theme is 'kindness'. Kindness is also one of Sutton Park Primary school's values. Today I would like you to show kindness by asking your parents if you can make a telephone or video call to someone you know who may be feeling lonely (e.g. a friend or family member). Alternatively, you could write them a letter, draw them a picture or make them a card. Have fun showing how kind you are!
