English Task

Remember to practise your phonics daily with Read Write Inc reading and spelling sessions on You Tube. Please try reading for 10-20 minutes each day. Most of you will be focusing on Set 3 sounds now.

Today I would like you to read and learn the poem attached 'Look at the Train' by Kathy Henderson. This is a fantastic poem that you can make sound just like a train as you read it. You could ask a grown up to read it to you first. Can you hear the rhythm in the poem? Can you learn the poem? Can you make it sound like a train as you say each line e.g. 'flickety flick, clickety click'. Don't forget to say words typed in bold font **LOUDLY!** I would love to see a video of you performing the poem.

Tomorrow you are going to change this poem so you create your own poem about a different form of transport. You could start thinking about your ideas today.

Maths Task

Everyone start by playing <https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/mental-maths-train>. Choose either '+' or '-' and then a level. If it is too tricky try an easier level and if it is too easy try a harder level.

Today we are continuing to use arrays for multiplication. Y2's/4 - Can you remember what an array is? Today all pupils can have a go at playing the game <https://www.ictgames.com/mobilePage/arrayDisplay/index.html> by rolling your dice two times to create a multiplication number sentence e.g. $4 \times 2 =$. '4 lots of 2 equals' (YR/1) or '4 times 2 equals' (Y2's) or '4 multiplied by 2 equals' (Y2's/4). Use it in the online game and record it on paper using the array to calculate the answer. Can you talk about the array created as you do this?

Foundation Subject Task

This week is Mental Health Awareness week. This year's theme is 'kindness'. Kindness is also one of Sutton Park Primary school's values. Today I would like you to show kindness by choosing a member of your family or a friend and telling them all the things you like about them (giving compliments) and saying thank you for all the things they do for you. You are really good at giving compliments in the Language Class so I know you can do this! You could write this down in a big list so they can keep it and look at it all day. I am sure it would make them smile! Have fun showing how kind you are!
