Remember to use our word of the week when talking to your family. How many times can you use it correctly throughout the day?

Word of the Week:

Word: block (noun / verb)

Definition: to stop or a solid piece of building material.

Synonym (words with similar meanings): chunk, piece.

Antonym (words with opposite meanings): unblock, open


Here is an example of how you could present your findings:
