Phonics: Today we are going back to remind ourselves of the Set 2 sounds. Today's sounds are 'ay' as in **play** and 'ee' as in **tree**. Write a list of words that rhyme with goat then do the same with stew. Search Ruth Miskin on YouTube for more phonic lessons. (The sounds today are set 3 sounds)

Maths Task


