### Welcome Comment



### English Task

Today I want you to head to <https://www.getepic.com/sign-in/educator> and read a special book I have chosen and assigned to you. (A picture of it is below). Remember to use the class code uka 1730 to log in. I then want you to pick one of the quotes or stories and have a go at telling me why it inspired you. How might you use that advice in the future?



### Maths Task

Today I would like you to spend some time on Times Tables Rockstar's <https://trockstars.com/> and complete work on your times tables for 15 minutes, just to get you back in the swing of things.

Next, using a die from your resource pack to create your numbers, I would like you to work on your addition and subtraction skills today. Create ten addition and ten subtraction questions, with 4, 5 or 6 digits each. Work out the answers and then check them using the inverse method.

For an extra challenge, can you work out  $789,476 - 397,587$ . This will test your exchanging skills.

### Foundation Task

Mrs Digger has set a family Geography challenge for you today. Your challenge is to create a 'Map' of your daily walk. Think about where you go on your daily walk. Which landmarks will you see along your journey, maybe a school, church, friend's house, can you draw these landmarks? If you are not leaving your house at the moment, or do not have a garden of your own, it could be that you choose to draw a map of the inside of your house, maybe from your bedroom to the kitchen. Can you draw a pathway of what you see along your route, do you have to go down the stairs, past the front door? Email a picture of your map and your name to your class email address.
