Maths Task**Multiplication word problems.**

1. The teacher needs each table to have 9 pencils. There are 5 tables. How many pencils are there altogether?
2. Miss D wants to buy 2 lollies for each of her 5 friends. How many lollies will she need to buy?
3. Mrs Cornforth has 8 friends over for her birthday dinner. She cooks 2 fish fingers each. How many fish fingers does Mrs Cornforth have to buy for her friends?
4. The box of chocolates has 7 sweets on each layer and 5 layers. How many chocolates is there altogether?
5. 6 children have completed their sticker chart. Each chart holds 10 stickers. How many stickers have the teachers given out?
