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### Welcome Comment

Good morning Language Class. Here are today's activities.

**English Task** Please practise your phonics daily with Read Write Inc reading and spelling sessions on You Tube. Please try reading for 10-20 minutes each day.

Take a look again at the story 'Shark in the Park' by Nick Sharratt.

<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=nWRwBRVeGQs>. This story has lots of rhyming words in it. Can you find the rhyming words e.g. 'shark...park'. Write down as many rhyming words that you can find in the book. Next ask a grown up to play rhyming I-Spy. 'I spy with my little eye something that rhymes with star... (car)'. If you find identifying the rhyming word a bit tricky then ask a grown up to give you a choice e.g. is it star-hat or star-car? If you are feeling confident then you can be the 'teacher' and say the rhyme... can a grown up or brother or sister work out the rhyming word? I have attached a sheet of 'Rhyming games' to help develop awareness of rhyming if you would like more practice at this throughout the week.

### Maths Task


Everyone start by playing 'Maths Fishing' again. **Y1's** and **YR's** doubles and **Y2's** practise your times tables at <https://mathsframe.co.uk/en/resources/resource/306/Maths-Fishing-Multiplication>

Today I would like **YR's/ Y1's** to complete the 'Shark in the Park' addition worksheet to 20 (attached). If you found this easy next try writing your own addition number sentences (numbers between 0-10) and work them out without pictures/objects but just by counting on (on a number line or in your head). **Y2's** look at the video

Think about your 2 times table e.g.  $2 \times 2 = 4$  so 4 shared between 2 is 2 ( $4 \div 2 = 2$ ) Can you record division number sentences (sharing) for the rest of the 2 times table?
