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

English Task



Today we'd like you to choose one character from the story and have a go at writing a sentence about it. Remember to write your letter sounds in the order that you can hear them. For example: The rainbow fish didnt wont to shair hiz scayls.

Maths Task

Addition to 20 with a number line

Example: $14 + 3 = 17$

10 + 7 =

10 + 5 =

11 + 2 =

6 + 8 =

9 + 9 =

8 + 10 =

5 + 12 =

17 + 3 =

For today's maths activity we are going to try to add numbers together by using your number line and pencil that you have in your school pack.

- To calculate $10 + 7 = \underline{\quad}$:
- You will need to start with your pencil at the number 10 on your number line.
- Now you need to draw 7 jumps forward from number 10. E.g. 10-11, is one jump, 11-12 is the second jump, 12-13, is the third etc
- Which number did you land on after 7 jumps?
- You should have landed on number 17.

Now try the next number sentences and use the same method, remember to jump forward each time.

Foundation Subject Task

Have a go at painting your own Rainbow Fish. As rainbows are everywhere, at the moment, as a symbol of hope, we were wondering if you could try to use these colours to decorate your own Rainbow Fish. You could use paint, crayons, sequins, collage, whatever you have available.
